The School

The Toledo Islamic Academy is a private school serving students in grades preschool through twelfth. Founded in 1995, TIA is fully accredited by the State of Ohio Department of Education and by the North Central Association Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement (NCA CASI).

The current enrollment at TIA is 185 students. More specifically, our elementary student body includes 122 students and our middle school/high school is comprised of 63 students. Our students represent a wide spectrum of cultural and economic diversity. Approximately 57% of students receive free or reduced lunch.

All TIA students pursue a rigorous course of study with a balanced and successful college-preparatory focus. High school students are expected to complete the Ohio Core (course and credit guidelines for the State of Ohio) and must pass the Ohio Graduation Test before graduation. TIA students enroll in Honors and Advanced Placement (AP) courses in addition to their regular high school course. Many students also take additional courses through the Post-Secondary Enrollment Option (PSEO) program at The University of Toledo or other local colleges.

With TIA extending its AP course offerings this year to five AP courses (AP Biology, AP World History, AP English Literature & Composition, AP English Language & Composition and AP Calculus), students are thoroughly challenged in their academics. Student learning is evaluated through multiple assessments including traditional standardized tests such as Terra Nova, Ohio Achievement Assessment, Ohio Graduation Test, PSAT, ACT, SAT, and AP. In just three years of participation with the AP program, two students have achieved AP Scholar recognition and one student achieved recognition as an AP Scholar with Distinction.

Our school is immensely proud of the accomplishments of the students. We continuously strive to improve the academic experience at TIA in order to further challenge our students as we support them and help them grow into responsible and moral citizens in their global community.

The Faculty

The Toledo Islamic Academy has 39 staff members which yields a teacher to student ratio of 1 to 7. The average class size at TIA is 12 students.

Community Service

TIA students are required to complete 100 hours of community service/volunteer work during their high school years. Students participate in tutoring, volunteering for the Red Cross, Habitat for Humanity, Cherry St. Mission, Ronald McDonald House, Toledo Food Bank and other charitable organizations. Often staff will participate with students in these volunteer experiences to model the way of service.

Extracurricular

The comprehensive curriculum at TIA is paired with the 21st Century Community Learning Center (21st CCLC) After School Program which offers enrichment programs, clubs, homework help/tutoring, and community service projects. TIA also maintains a growing athletic department which offers extracurricular activities to students interested in sports. As members of the CSAC, our students have the opportunity to compete with schools in the area in various sports. In 2009 our middle school and high school flag football teams, as well as the cross country team were named CSAC champions.

Class of 2012

The graduating class of 2012 has six students. Each member of the senior class has passed all five sections of the OGT. Five out of the six seniors passed all sections on the first attempt. Due to its small class size, the school policy does not endorse class ranking with the exception of valedictorian and salutatorian. Five of the six seniors qualify for an Ohio Honors Diploma

Graduation and College Admission Status

Class of 2010 students received admission to some of the nation's best colleges and universities. In addition they received scholarship offers ranging from \$40,000 to \$212,000. For the class of 2011, the combined amount offered to students in scholarship totaled \$800,000.
